

TASK DESCRIPTIONS



MEDAL MAZE

Teams are challenged to thread a medal through all nine holes in a numbered board in turn to make the total value equal 100. Sounds easy but you must start by using the Number 1 hole first and the following eight holes must be in ascending order of value.



DIFFICULTY RATING(1 easy to 5 difficult) : 5

BATON BUILD

Faced with nine different shaped wooden pieces and a plastic tube; teams must use some or all of the pieces to make a complete relay baton that fits exactly inside the tube. A seemingly easy task that rapidly becomes taxing.
